Introduction

Solutions Asset Finance Ltd (“SAF”) is a UK based commercial organisation. While SAF does not currently meet the turnover threshold requiring mandatory publication under the Modern Slavery Act 2015, we recognise the importance and recognise the importance of preventing modern day slavery and human trafficking and support the objectives of the Modern Slavery Act 2015.

Company Background

SAF provides specialist commercial asset finance solutions to businesses across a range of sectors, including healthcare, education, life sciences, and green technologies. Our activities are predominantly UK based and focus on funding solutions that enable the acquisition and use of equipment, infrastructure, and other business-critical assets.

Risk Assessment

Given the nature of our business as a financial services provider, SAF considers the risk of modern slavery within our direct operations to be low. We do not operate high-risk industries, and we do not maintain complex international overseas supply chains. Our interactions are primarily with regulated businesses, professional service providers, and commercial clients within the UK.

Policies and Approach

Although we are not legally required to maintain formal anti-slavery policies, Solutions Asset Finance Ltd operates in a manner consistent with preventing modern slavery, including:

- Conducting our business with integrity, professionalism, and transparency
- Working with reputable, regulated, and established partners
- Avoiding engagement with organisations where ethical or compliance concerns are identified
- Promoting awareness of ethical standards and responsible conduct within our organisation

Due Diligence

SAF applies proportionate, risk based due diligence processes appropriate to the nature of our operations. These include checks on our business partners, engagement with established and regulated organisations, and ongoing awareness of risks associated with financial crime and unethical practices and compliance failures.

Training and Awareness

SAF promotes general awareness of ethical business conduct among employees. Given the low-risk profile of our business, formal training specific to modern slavery is not currently provided, but this will be kept under review and implemented where necessary.

Ongoing Commitment

SAF remains committed to monitoring and reviewing and improving the practices and policies in place surrounding modern slavery.
